Information about the neighborhood and city	<p>- Utrera is a town of around 50.000 habitantes, located 30 km from Seville. Its historic center was declared a historic-artistic site of cultural interest in 2002. It is considered one of the historical birth-places of flamenco.</p> <p>Link to a web page with information of the town: https://www.visitarsevilla.com/provincia/campina/utrera/</p>
Getting to school	<p>- Utrera has a train station so it is well connected to the capital. Link to the website of the train services to check the transport schedules: https://www.renfe.com/es/es/cercanias/cercanias-sevilla/horarios</p> <p>- The train station is 30 minutes walk from the school. Buses can also be taken to get to the school from the train station, in particular line L4.</p>
Accommodation - Where to live in town? - Possibility of staying with a family? - Possibility of sharing a flat with other teachers or language assistants?	<p>- Language assistants can get an accommodation in Utrera, although other language assistants from previous years have stayed in Seville from where they would come everyday by train.</p> <p>- In case of staying in Utrera, they can rent a flat from 450 euros per month.</p>
